

2010 Lady Irish Golf  
Program Service Project

The Lady Irish Golf program in an effort to serve the most vulnerable in Oklahoma and to represent Bishop McGuinness Catholic High School and the Archdiocese of OKC in a manner prototypical of “a person for others” has chosen to partner with Birth Choice of Oklahoma for a season long team service project called “Birdies for Babies.”

“Birdies for Babies” is designed to provide incentive to the Lady Irish Golf team to compete at their highest level on the golf course for a cause greater than themselves. The girls golf team with support from family, friends, and the broader community will serve to support the needs of the most vulnerable in our society.

The “Birdies for Babies” service project will work as follows:

1. Student/Athletes from the girls golf program will seek out support in their community to make a pledge of \$1 for every birdie, eagle, double eagle, and hole in one made by any competing member of the Lady Irish Golf team during a sanctioned golf tournament for the 2010 season.
2. Based on the current schedule for the 2010 season there would be a total of 1,422 holes to be played in competition by Lady Irish golfers. If each player made 1 birdie per round, each pledge made to the golf team would be valued at \$79 for the entire season. (It would be rare for each player to average a birdie or better per round. The service project is motivation for the team)
3. Each pledge applies to all team members playing in a sanctioned tournament.
4. Each pledge will be capped at \$79 for the season. All funds will be committed to Birth Choice of Oklahoma. The Lady Irish Golf program and Bishop McGuinness will not keep any of the funds.
5. Birth Choice of Oklahoma is a nonprofit organization. It has been operating for 37 years. The organization provides medical care, pregnancy tests, ultra sounds, and shelters for homeless, pregnant women. They also provide the mother with formula, diapers, clothes, and other necessary items for their baby. Birth Choice truly serves the most vulnerable among us.
6. All pledges will be collected on Friday, May 7<sup>th</sup> based on the Lady Irish season birdie performance. The tax-deductible donation should be made payable to Bishop McGuinness. The Lady Irish Golf Team will present the donated funds to Birth Choice of Oklahoma on Friday, May 14<sup>th</sup>.
7. Ongoing results and updates on money raised for the “Birdies for Babies” service project will be reported on Twitter. All program supporters making a pledge to cooperate with the Lady Irish Golf program in its service project this season are encouraged to follow “ladyirishgolf” on Twitter to watch our progress during the season.
